Dear Friends in Christ,

Janet will be responsible for screening and training all employees and volunteers who work with children at our parish and parish school. Deirdre Hite, our former Safe Environment Coordinator, decided to cut back her working hours for her Parish Staff position, and thus the reason for bringing Janet on board in this important position. Thanks to Deirdre for her work in getting this program started in July 2003 and moving it forward to where it is today.

All volunteers in our parish and parish school are invited to an annual party thanking you for your service. This party will take place at 6 p.m. on Sat., Feb. 4th. Come and bring your family members with you. Starting at 9 a.m. on the same day (Feb. 4th) will be a keynote address on liturgy followed by workshops that focus on different aspects of the Mass: Liturgy of the Word, Liturgy of the Eucharist, the role of music at Mass, and the importance of hospitality. This morning of formation will be very beneficial for our liturgical ministers (Communion ministers, lectors, ushers, greeters, choir members, sacristans) but it is open to the entire parish, so feel free to come and deepen your understanding of the Mass.
