Dear Friends in Christ,

Beginning this Monday, **the parish office will be open during the lunch hour from 12 noon – 1 p.m.** Our volunteer receptionists who had been coming from 1-4 p.m. to help answer the phone and assist with other tasks, will start coming to the office at 12 noon. So, parish office hours will now be from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday-Friday.

The Safe and Secure Committee for our parish school has been meeting to review security at our school and to make recommendations for a safer school environment. The children in grades 1-8 are in the new school building, which is locked down all day. However, the children in our preschool (3 and 4 year-olds) and kindergarten classes are in classrooms where the building cannot be locked down because of all the parish meetings and gatherings that take place during the day in the church, chapel, offices, and meeting rooms. The only entrance that is open during school hours into the parish facilities is the main entrance under the steeple. When you come into the building, please stop by the parish office and sign in and receive an identification sticker so that we can better ensure the safety of the smallest of our schoolchildren. I know this can be a bit of a hassle, but this small sacrifice will help make the parish building a safer place for our school children.

Thanks to those who have given to this year's ADF appeal. Gifts from donors who gave in advance totaled \$51,000 and for those who pledged last weekend, the total amount is being calculated while this bulletin is going to press. The goal for our parish for this year's ADF appeal is \$134,057 and an increase of 10% in the number of donors. If you have not yet filled out a pledge envelope, please take an ADF envelope and do so.

The dates for our parish pilgrimage to Spain, In the Footsteps of Saints, have been moved to October 8-18, 2006. It is a fortuitous move because we are able to enjoy a cooler climate and lower prices! The price is \$2,995 based on 30 pilgrims. Our pilgrimage will begin with Mass at the Basilica of La Macarena in Seville and the next morning we will celebrate Mass at Seville's Cathedral, the third largest cathedral in the world. The itinerary includes Cordoba, Granada, Toledo, Segovia, Avila, and Madrid. We will be in Avila to celebrate the feast day of her patron, St. Teresa. Spain's gentle ambiance and passionate culture have given life to great saints such as St. Teresa, St. Ignatius and St. John of the Cross. It inspired renowned artists such as El Greco and Murillo in their portrayals of Christ and His saints. A pilgrimage is a special time of spiritual renewal and conversion.

Deacon Bill Bawden, who presently works full time as a member of the parish staff at St. John the Baptist Church in Edmond, will be coming to work full time as a member of our parish staff beginning July 1, 2006. I will share more with you in the near future about what Deacon Bawden will be doing here.

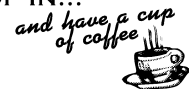
