Dear Friends in Christ,

In the February 12th issue of the Sooner Catholic, Archbishop Beltran issued a pastoral letter entitled, "Raising Our Voices: In Opposition to Violence Against Women." In this letter, the Archbishop stated that since women are created in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1: 27), **violence against women is sinful**. Archbishop Beltran noted that one of every four American women will experience violence by an intimate partner and one of every six will be raped in her lifetime. Women in other parts of the world are even more at risk of violence, especially in human trafficking that makes them objects of sexual slavery and in wartime where violence against women is used as a weapon of war. (Women in our own country suffer from the effects of war as some husbands who return home from war suffering from post-traumatic stress syndrome can be abusive.)

A year ago Archbishop Beltran joined other religious leaders in a public declaration condemning the violence in our society perpetrated against women. This year the Archbishop invites the participation of all Catholics in raising our voices in opposition to violence against women. **Archbishop Beltran asks all Catholics to sign a special declaration condemning violence against women, which you will be able to do this weekend.** He will present these signatures at the Feb. 22nd meeting of religious leaders at a press conference at the State Capitol. (This begins at 12 noon on Wednesday in the "Blue Room" and you are invited to attend.) The weekend of February 25-26 will be a special time of prayer in every parish in our Archdiocese asking God to help us bring an end to violence against women.

On Tuesday **additional lights were added** to the three parking lot light poles in the parking lot in front of the church and also to the two light poles in the school parking lot. The total cost was \$4160, which was less than the initial estimate of \$5000. Thanks to the donors who provided the funds for this project: the Card Circle and Altar Society each gave \$1000, and Steve Voelker gave \$2500 from his mother's estate.

The renovation of the bathrooms across the hall from the nursery **has been completed.** Thanks to Pat Lesseg for the many hours he spent overseeing the renovation of these bathrooms and the other set of bathrooms on the west side of the gym. Thanks to Alberto Aquirre, Alejandro Randolph, Art Valdez and others who freely gave of their time and effort to help with this project.

Thank you to the 309 donors who have pledged \$104,549 to this year's ADF drive. We are still \$30,000 short of our goal, so please fill our your ADF envelope today. On the facing page of this bulletin is a notice about the **St. Vincent de Paul food pantry needing donations**. Please bring the requested items so we can help those who come to us in need. Fr. David True, a priest of our archdiocese, died this past week. I ask that you pray for the peaceful repose of his soul.
