Next Sunday is Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. The Mass of the Lord's Supper will be celebrated on Holy Thursday @ 7 p.m. (Mar. 24), the Celebration of the Lord's Passion will be Good Friday @ 6:30 p.m. in English and 8:30 p.m. in Spanish (*Mar. 25*) and the Great Easter Vigil will be at 8 p.m. on Holy Saturday, March 26th. There will be no Confessions on Holy Saturday nor will there be the regularly scheduled 5 p.m. Vigil Mass--the only Mass offered on Holy Saturday will be the 8 p.m. Easter Vigil Mass.

If you are a registered parishioner, you should have received your Census Form through the mail by now. Please take 5 minutes to fill it out and then you can put it in the enclosed envelope and mail it to the church, or drop it by the parish office, or place it in the Sunday collection basket. Your participation in this process will help in our planning for the future of our parish.

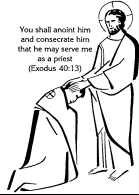

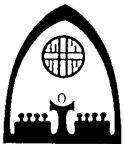

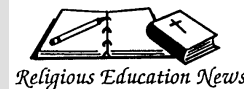

A special private telephone number, 405-720-9878 has been installed through the direction of the Archbishop, as a pastoral response to anyone who, as a child or minor, was sexually abused by a priest. The telephone calls will be answered by a trained counselor.

The purpose of the telephone line is twofold. First, it will give a voice to any victim, enabling them to report the allegations of abuse. Therefore, it may be the first step of investigation. Second, the telephone line will provide access to pastoral counseling. This may be the initial step to bring healing and comfort to the victim. The line is answered weekdays between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., or at other hours by a confidential answering machine. Messages are retrieved and returned as soon as possible.
