## ✚ Pastor's Notes

*Dear Friends in Christ,*

Christ is Risen!! Alleluia! Alleluia! We gather together with great joy today to celebrate the Resurrection of Christ and our participation with him in the new life that he brings. I extend a warm welcome to all of our visitors who worship with us today and to those Catholics who are coming back home.

We continue to move forward with plans for a new church building. Presently a parish census is being conducted to better determine the make-up of our parish to help with these plans. After the census is completed, a building committee will be assembled to start the next stage of this process. Easter Sunday is always a concrete reminder of our need for a larger worship space. Because of the fire code disallowing the placement of folding chairs along the wall inside the church or in the gathering area, many of you will have to stand throughout the Masses this morning.

The 50 days of the Easter Season, stretching from Easter Sunday to Pentecost, are a time of great rejoicing in the gift of the Spirit of the Risen Lord poured out upon his people. So, throughout these 50 days the Sacraments are celebrated in a special way. Baptisms will take place at a number of Sunday Masses. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be celebrated on April 16-17. Confirmation will be on April 22<sup>nd</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> Communion on April 30 & May 1.

Women and men who experience an abortion live with that death and need to encounter the healing presence of the Risen Lord. The Church provides an opportunity for this healing encounter through the Rachel's Vineyard weekend retreat taking place from Friday evening, April 1<sup>st</sup> thru Sunday afternoon, April 3<sup>rd</sup>, at the Catholic Pastoral Center here in OKC. This retreat, which is a program of the Office of Family Life, offers an opportunity to deeply enter into the grieving process and identify the ways your abortion may have affected you. 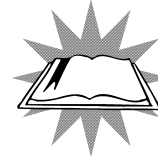

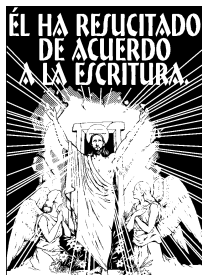

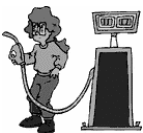
