Dear Friends in Christ,

With the celebration of Palm Sunday we enter into the holiest week of the year. This week is a gift from the Church to us, a time set aside to remember what is most important in our life. The dying and rising of the Lord Jesus, Son of God and Son of Mary, transforms all of creation and all history. With the special opportunities for prayer this week, we plunge ever deeper into this saving mystery of God's enduring love and are transformed, dying with Christ and rising with him to new life.

One of the beautiful celebrations of this week that the Church of our Archdiocese celebrates is the **Chrism Mass** on **Tuesday night at 6 p.m.** at the Cathedral of Our Lady of Perpetual Help. At this Mass, Archbishop Beltran blesses the holy oils (Oil of Catechumens, Oil of the Sick, Sacred Chrism) that will be used during the coming year. Michael Stewart, one of our catechumens who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil, and Judi Wilkinson, director of RCIA and Adult Formation, will present the Oil of Catechumens to Archbishop Beltran. Also, all the priests of our Archdiocese come to this Mass and renew their priestly commitment. Anyone can attend the Chrism Mass, but plan to come early if you would like a seat.

Also, remember that after the Stations of the Cross on Good Friday at 12 p.m., the cross will be put out for veneration until before the Celebration of the Passion of the Lord at 7 p.m. This is being done so that those who cannot come to venerate the cross during the evening can do so at some time during the afternoon of Good Friday.

Eighteen priests traveled to Guymon to St. Peter Church last Monday evening to assist Fr. Pruett with his Lenten Penance Rite. The church was full of penitents, and I was glad to be part of that celebration. Fr. Pruett fed us a delicious meal after the Penance Rite, and I assured him of our prayers as he ministers to the numerous Catholics in the Panhandle.

Dan and Mary Kelley will receive a special blessing at the 5 p.m. Saturday Mass this weekend as they celebrate 50 years of marriage. Congratulations to the Kelleys!

If you would like to go on the pilgrimage to Spain this October, your deposit is due now. Come learn more about some of the Church's most influential saints, such as St. John of the Cross and St. Teresa of Avila, and discover how the three great religions of the world (Judaism, Islam, and Christianity) coexisted peacefully in Spain.

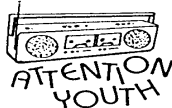

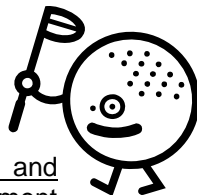
