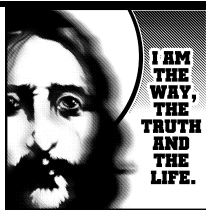

from the Pastors Desk

Dear Friends in Christ,

Habemus papam: We have a Pope. The news echoed round the world this past Tuesday, April 19th, as Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger was elected the 265th Pope of the Roman Catholic Church and chose the name Benedict XVI. By now you have probably heard a lot about the newly elected pope. He is German, 78 years old (of which 54 of those years have been spent as a priest), and is one of only two cardinals in the recent conclave who was not appointed a cardinal by Pope John Paul II. Because Pope Benedict XVI had been head of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith for the past 24 years and had worked closely with Pope John Paul II, he is fairly well-known not only in Rome but also throughout the world. Both Catholics who are happy and those who are unhappy with his election feel like they already know the man and have already decided what kind of pope he will be. My inclination is to give Pope Benedict XVI time to fit into his new role--we may all be surprised at the outcome. Also, his first words after being elected were to plead for our prayers, which he will definitely need as he faces the challenges of leading a worldwide church with 1.1 billion members.

Outstanding lay Catholics from our Archdiocese will be honored by the new pope with a special papal award entitled "Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice" at the Centennial Mass at 3 p.m. on Sunday afternoon, August 14th at the Cox Convention Center. This papal award is given to Catholics who have contributed greatly to the life of their local parish over a significant period of time. Four members of our parish will be so honored: **Irene Alsobrook, Marie Downey, Theresa Nagel-Smith, and Edward O'Connor.** I hope many of our parishioners will come to the Centennial Mass on Aug. 14 for this special celebration.

Also during this Centennial Year of the foundation of the Diocese of Oklahoma, pilgrimages are being encouraged to significant historical sites. Please take a Centennial Pilgrimage Passport book, found on the countertop in the gathering area, and use it as a guide to visit one or more pilgrimage sites. Exploring the history of the Catholic Church in Oklahoma gives us an opportunity to recall the sacrifices of our ancestors in faith and to deepen our own faith.

On Sat., April 23rd, Mrs. De Schmidt of our parish was honored as "Women of the Year" from our parish at an annual recognition ceremony at the Cathedral with other Catholic women from other parishes. Our Altar Society nominated De for this award. Congratulations De!

Late-Nite Catechism netted \$6000 in profit, and this money will go toward the summer renovation of the bathrooms on the west and east side of our Fellowship Hall. This weekend at Mass young people from our parish who have gone on a mission trip to serve at a Catholic Heart Workcamp will briefly share their experience. Finally, 1st Communion will be celebrated for our 2nd grade students at the Masses next weekend.
