Dear Friends in Christ,

The annual Friends of Bolivia Medical Mission that our parish sponsors will take place this year from May 26 – June 5. **The Friends of Bolivia auction on Feb. 11th netted \$ 14,300.** Besides this auction, our parish also takes up a special 2nd Collection to support this medical mission. This special collection will take place next weekend at all the Masses.

Our parishioners support and are actively involved in other forms of outreach to those who are in need.

Through our Laughlin House we provide lodging and support for a homeless family. (Rob Fraser is the chair of the Laughlin House Committee.) The Mobile Meals ministry to shut-ins takes place every Monday. The day-in and day-out assistance to the impoverished within our parish boundaries is undertaken by the members of our St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) Conference, whose president is Jack Dewitt. Members go in pairs to conduct home visits to better assess needs and also to provide the ministry of loving presence to those in need. Each year our SVDP Conference receives around \$50,000 in donations, mainly from parishioners. You may have seen a special bulletin notice in last week's bulletin asking for donations through the monthly SVDP envelope because of high ONG bills. Also, the high cost of gasoline is causing challenges for people struggling to make ends meet.

Because we have such a dedicated group of parish volunteers who respond to the material needs of others on a daily basis, please **do not give cash to anyone who approaches you on our parish property.** Simply take them to the telephone outside of the parish office, ask them to dial Extension 155 (SVDP extension), and then give the information requested. Within 24 hours they will be contacted and assisted by a SVDP member. SVDP has provided our office staff with gas and food coupons for those who have immediate needs, and these coupons are given out during office hours. In addition, non-perishable food items are available through the SVDP food closet.

This Sunday afternoon at 3:30 p.m. in our gym the fathers of our 8th graders and I will take on the 8th grade boys in a basketball game to raise funds for the School Scholarship Endowment Fund.

This Wednesday night is the last night of Religious Education classes for this school year. Vacation Bible School is less than a month away, for it will take place June 5-9.
