Dear Friends in Christ,

To all women whom we call "Mother" we extend a Happy Mother's Day today. For many of us who are Catholic, our mothers played a vital role in passing on the Faith to us. May all of our mothers who are deceased rest in the peace and joy of the Lord.

On August 17, 1905, Pope St. Pius X established the Diocese of Oklahoma. Due to the growth of the Church in Oklahoma during the last century, the State was split into two separate dioceses: the Diocese of Tulsa and the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City. During this 100th Anniversary year, a special book has been published

called "**Roman and Oklahoman: A Centennial History of the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City.**" Fr. James D. White of the Tulsa Diocese is the author. This book honors the faith-filled Catholics of the Church our Archdiocese of Oklahoma City and gives a brief summary of the various parishes and religious organizations and institutions. In the brief description of our parish, there is a typo—Bishop McGuinness died on December 27, 1957 (not 1975). There are many interesting sections of this book, one being "*Catholic Women in Oklahoma*" where two of our parishioners, Shirley Cox and Tish Eason, are profiled. Shirley and Tish are just two of many lay women, who are also mothers, who have contributed to the life of the Church in Oklahoma. This book costs \$25. You will find an order form in this week's bulletin. Parish staff members will be in the gathering area with these books available for sale after Mass.

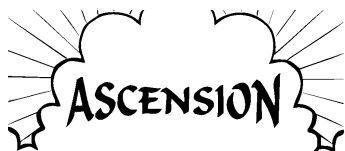
