Dear Friends in Christ,

We conclude the celebration of the Easter Season this weekend with the **great feast of Pentecost**. In a world that has been united by the Internet but becoming more and more divided in other ways, we pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit, who makes us one in Christ in the midst of our diversity.

Next **Saturday, May 21st at the 5 p.m. Mass the 8th Grade class** from our parish school will be presented with their diplomas **toward the end of Mass after Communion**. Twenty-nine students will graduate this year from our school. The surgeon told me after my operation that this growth had been pressing down on the nerves of my thumb, so it was good that it was removed. The recovery process has been a bit of an adventure because I am right-handed, and I never realized until now how the thumb is really the most important digit on the hand. I appreciate all the prayers and concern that have been expressed.

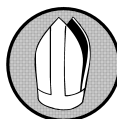
