from the Pastors Desk

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today we celebrate *Corpus Christi*—the Feast of the Body and Blood of the Lord. On Pentecost we rejoiced in the gift of the Spirit last week on Trinity Sunday we celebrated the gift of relationships, and today we delight in the gift of food as the Lord shares his life with us through this sacred meal. As for the celebration of Memorial Day, Mass will be offered on Monday at 9 a.m.

Beginning the first week of June we switch to our "Summer Schedule" for our Wednesday prayer events and for Thursday Mass. For the Wednesdays from June 1 till the Wednesday after Labor Day (Sept. 7), Confessions will only be offered on the First Wednesday of the month from 12 noon – 1 p.m. and 8:00 – 8:30 p.m. (Confessions are offered every Saturday from 3-4 p.m.) Also, Anointing of the Sick will take place only on the First Wednesday of the month at 3 p.m. in the chapel, instead of every Wednesday. (Please call the parish office at 751-7115 if you or a loved one needs the Sacrament of the Anointing and cannot come on the first Wednesday.) Finally, the regular 8:30 p.m. time for Evening Prayer and Benediction will only be on the First Wednesdays during June-August, while the other Wednesdays during this time period Evening Prayer and Benediction will take place at 7 p.m. **As for Thursday Mass, beginning June 2, Mass will be celebrated at 7:30 a.m. until school resumes in mid-August.**

This coming Thursday, June 2nd, also happens to be our patronal feast day--the Feast of Pope St. Eugene--so come at 7:30 a.m. for Mass to celebrate this special day for our parish.

The 5:30 p.m. Mass on Sunday evening will continue throughout the summer. In fact, this Mass is now a permanent fixture in our weekend Mass schedule. John Spaid, who is the leader of the contemporary choir at this Mass, will be gone for most of the summer, but will return in early August.

Fr. Rex Arnold will preside at the 5 p.m. Sunday Vigil Mass (Saturday evening Mass) this weekend. As many of you know, Fr. Arnold was a member of our parish and was ordained on June 4, 2004, and celebrated his First Mass here on June 5th last year. He is presently serving as associate pastor at the Catholic Church of St. John the Baptist in Edmond.

Deacon Joe Irwin will be ordained to the priesthood for our Archdiocese on June 3rd. Deacon Irwin spent a summer in Altus with me while he was a seminarian to learn more about parish life. He is the only priest who will be ordained this year for our Archdiocese. I hope to attend his First Mass at St. Joseph Church in Norman on Saturday evening, June 4th.

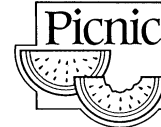
