Dear Friends in Christ,

Today we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**, which was first celebrated by the universal church as "*Corpus Christi*" in 1264. The feast originated in an age when, because of the penitential practices, the faithful rarely received communion but adored the real presence of Christ from a distance, in the reserved Eucharistic host. At that time, the faithful never shared the chalice either. It is therefore not surprising that the feast became known simply as "*Corpus Christi*" and focused exclusively on Christ's presence under the form of bread. Today's calendar combines this feast with the formerly separate feast of the Blood of Christ into a single celebration. Thus, this feast calls us to deepen our faith in the whole eucharistic mystery. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, ordinary bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. St. Augustine reminds us that when we share in communion we become what we receive: the Body and Blood of Christ. Thus, we receive the real presence of Christ and become his presence in the world.

Deacon Duane Descher, who has been serving as coordinator of our Marriage Preparation ministry for a number of years, has turned over the leadership of this ministry to **Terry and Susan Givens**. Thanks to Duane and his wife, Charlotte, for their dedicated service. More married couples are needed to help prepare engaged couples for the Sacrament of Matrimony, so if you are interested in this ministry, call Terry or Susan at 752-0059.

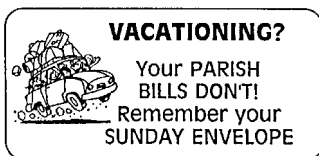
