From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends in Christ,

Pat Lesseg, chair of our Maintenance and Property Board, has been hard at work collecting bids for the renovation of 2 sets of restrooms: the men and women's restrooms on the west side of the gym and the men and women's restrooms to the east of the kitchen (across the hall from the nursery and Hispanic Ministry Office). At their May meeting, the Finance Committee approved using up to \$25,000 from our School Education Trust Fund for the renovation of these bathrooms. (This fund was established for major repairs and/or renovations to the parish or parish school facilities.) The \$6,000 that was raised from Late Nite Catechism in April will also be used to help pay for this project. These bathrooms are used by schoolchildren and by parishioners attending meetings or activities in the gym/meeting room part of our building. They are badly in need of repair and will be renovated to look like the bathrooms in the school, with new tile floors, new countertops, new mirrors, improved lighting, repainting, and the addition of diaper changing tables. Hopefully, demolition and repair work will begin this weekend on the restrooms on the west end of the gym, and when these restrooms are completed, then the work will begin on the other set of restrooms.

June is the month when many of our parish committees welcome new members and new leadership. The Hispanic Council welcomes two new members: Alejandro Ramirez and Sofia Brannon. Jesus Elizondo is the new president of this group. While the vice-president is Alberto Aguirre, the treasurer is Roberto Zarate, the secretary is Sofia Brannon, and the historian is Alejandro Ramirez. Barbara Hatfield, who has been the chairperson of the Stewardship Committee for the past several years, is turning over the leadership of that group to Bryan Williams. Sylvia Valdez will be the vice-chairperson and Barbara has moved into the position of secretary. The School Advisory Council hosted an evening of discernment earlier this month which concluded with the selection of Mary Knutson to serve on this council that advises the principal and pastor concerning our parish school. Cathy Ditmars moves into her 2nd year as chair of this group.

With \$75,000 raised so far, we are three-fourths of the way toward our \$100,000 Centennial Challenge goal. As you can see in the financial table below, collections are below budget by almost \$60,000, the majority of that is a decrease in giving to our Building for the Millennium (BFM) Fund. The gifts through these monthly BFM envelopes help pay our monthly long-term debt payment of almost \$16,000. Help our parish catch-up and even give us a little breathing room by stepping forward with your donation to the Centennial Challenge.

Fr. Lawrence, president of St. Gregory University, will be here the weekend of July 9-10 to talk about St. Greg's and take up a special collection for their scholarship fund.
