Dear Friends in Christ,

Please **welcome Fr. Nicholas Ast**, O.S.B., who speak at all the Masses this weekend about the important ministry provided by the only Catholic university in Oklahoma---**St. Gregory's University** in Shawnee. As we prepare to celebrate the 230th anniversary of the founding of our country, we are faced with important challenges, not just in Iraq but right here at home. The most recent newsletter of *The Catholic Campaign for Human Development* (CCHD is sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) reports that after a decade of decline, the proportion of children living in low-income families is rising again, a trend that began in 2000. Thirteen million American children now live in poverty--that's one in six. Children represent 35.2 percent of all Americans living in poverty, yet they comprise only 25.2 percent of the total population. A startling statistic released in May is that America ranks near the bottom among modern nations (better only than Latvia) in the survival rate for newborn babies with a death rate of nearly 5 per 1000. In Oklahoma nearly 8 infants die out of every 1000 live births. CCHD and other organizations address these challenges faced by our most vulnerable citizens, but political willpower is also needed to improve the quality of life for children in America.

Deacon Bill Bawden begins his ministry among us this Monday, July 3rd. His office is located down the hallway from the parish office in the section of offices where Karen Bernardy and Judi Wilkinson's offices are located. Deacon Bawden will preach at all the Masses on the weekend of July 15-16 with receptions after each Mass to welcome Bill and his wife, Sylvia, to our parish.

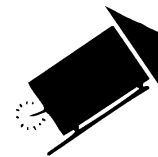
