from the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends in Christ,

The "End-of-Life" Seminar held on June 28th was well attended (between 75-100 people) and the presentations were well done. Polly Keenan, our parish nurse, did a fine job organizing this event. If you were not able to attend, you can purchase a DVD of the entire 2-hour seminar. If you are interested in such a purchase, visit with Polly.

LeAnn Hufnagel has decided to resign from her position as Coordinator of Youth and Young Adult Ministries effective this September when her baby is due. LeAnn began work here in January 2003, and she has faithfully and generously shared her talents with the young people of our parish. LeAnn will be leading a Search Committee that will look for her replacement. Please pray that we will be able to hire someone like LeAnn who has a strong faith and love for young people.

Our Parish Census continues to move forward with phone calls being made on a weekly basis to those who have not filled out a Census form. These forms are available on the countertop in the gathering area---if you have not done so, please take one and complete it and save our callers some valuable time. Once the Parish Census is completed we will have valuable data to give to a Building Committee (to be formed this Fall) for plans for a new church.

Deacon-candidate Jerry Rakosky will be leading a prayer vigil in the chapel on the evening before scheduled executions in our State. At these vigils, prayers will be offered for the victims who have been killed, for their families, for the person to be executed and for their family members, and for all involved in the death penalty process. The next scheduled execution is on July 19th, so a prayer vigil has been scheduled for July 18th at 6 p.m.

This year the U.S. Bishops have launched a major campaign to end the death penalty in the United States. The U.S. Bishops Conference has opposed the death penalty for 25 years, so this cause is not a new one, but this campaign brings a greater sense of urgency and energy to end the death penalty in our nation at a time when more and more Catholics oppose it. One pollster discovered in a November 2004 survey that 1/3 of Catholics who once supported the use of the death penalty now oppose it. As Cardinal McCarrick, archbishop of Washington declared, *"We cannot teach that killing is wrong by killing. We cannot defend life by taking life."*

Please remember to continue your financial support of our parish during these summer months. Even though you may not be here because of taking time away for a vacation, there is no vacation when it comes to paying the bills and supplying the salaries for our parish staff and school faculty. Thank you for your continued support.

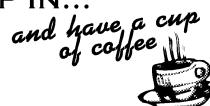

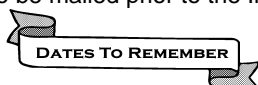
