This Wednesday, July 19, at 6 p.m. there will be a special Mass at Holy Trinity Catholic Church in Okarche to celebrate the **25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the death of Fr. Stanley Rother**. Also, there will be a short memorial service at Holy Trinity Cemetery in Okarche where Fr. Rother is buried on Sunday, July 30, at 3 p.m.

Thanks to those of you who responded so generously to the appeal by Fr. Nicholas for the St. Gregory University Scholarship Fund. You will note in the "Summary of Contributions" section below that the collection here at the church was \$4100. Sr. Julia, administrative assistant to the President of St. Gregory (Abbot Lawrence) has informed us that St. Gregory University has also received some generous contributions through the mail from our parishioners to raise our total parish gift to almost \$10,000.

Generous gifts have also been received to improve our parish facilities as well. A parish family gave a gift of \$26,500 to pay for new microphones for the priest and deacon in the church, and a new sound system for our gym/parish hall and meeting rooms. The priest and deacon at Mass are using a cordless mike that is almost invisible, which hooks over the ear and comes down near the mouth. The quality of sound is very good. Also, several gifts made possible the purchase of a new heating and air conditioning unit for the rectory, which cost \$3250.

Thanks to all who made and **sold tamales** for \$1250, to **Mary Jo Spears and members of the Card Circle** who donated \$1250, and to a **parish family that donated** the remaining \$750. Thanks to **Jesus Elizondo** who had the idea for the tamale sale and who also had the new unit installed free of charge through his business.

The 2006-2007 Parish Budget was approved at our Parish Council meeting in June, and it will be printed in the September issue of the *Gospel Truth*. A new target figure of \$28,000 has been set for our weekly collections, which can be found below in the "Summary of Contributions" section.

Fr. Ross left this past Friday, July 14, for Eastern Europe to visit Prague and Budapest and will return to our parish on July 26.

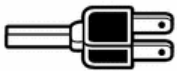
