*From the Pastor's Desk*

Dear friends in Christ,

The Centennial Mass celebrating 100 years since the founding of the Diocese of Oklahoma is just around the corner. It will take place on **Sunday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, at 3 p.m. at the Cox Cable Center** in downtown Oklahoma City. There will be a video presentation @ 2:30 p.m. giving a brief overview of the past 100 years. More than 10 bishops, scores of priests and deacons, and thousands of lay people will be in attendance. During the Mass, those lay people chosen for the "Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice" (For the Church and the Pontiff) awards will receive these from Archbishop Beltran after his homily. Four members of our parish will be honored: Irene Alsobrook, Marie Downey, Ed O'Connor, and Theresa Nagel-Smith. The collection from this Mass will be given to the former mission of our Archdiocese in Guatemala at Santiago-Atitlan.

Archbishop Beltran has urged parishes to consider canceling any Sunday Masses that might conflict with this grand celebration of faith, so we are canceling our 5:30 p.m. Mass on Sunday, August 14<sup>th</sup>. Also, the Mass will feature music in the languages (English, Spanish, and Vietnamese) of the different cultures that bring so much richness to the Church of Oklahoma. Because the sung acclamations (Sanctus, Memorial Acclamation, Lamb of God) will be in English and Spanish, parishes have been asked to sing these acclamations at their regular Masses so people will be better prepared to participate in singing these important parts of the Mass. We will sing these bi-lingual acclamations at the 5 p.m. Saturday Mass and 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. Sunday Masses on July 30-31 and August 6-7. Also, all the parishes of our Archdiocese will listen to a brief audio-tape by Archbishop Beltran at all the Masses on August 6-7 about this special celebration of the Church and for the Church of Oklahoma. I encourage you to attend this Centennial Mass. Take this golden opportunity to connect with the wider Church and to give thanks for all the people who have gone before us, sowing the seeds of faith in Oklahoma.

Just as the local parishes support the work of the Archdiocese, so does the Archdiocese support local parishes. For the past several years, Archbishop Beltran has given \$500,000 of the Archdiocesan Fund Appeal to aid Catholic education in our Archdiocese. This week our school received a check for \$25,031 from this fund. Checks have been sent to other grade schools throughout our Archdiocese, as well as high schools (e.g., \$91,000 to Bishop McGuinness High School) and on the college level as well (\$100,000 for St. Gregory's University in Shawnee). The generous response of so many of you to the annual ADF appeal makes this ongoing support of Catholic education possible.

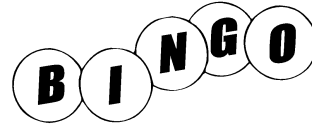
