Dear Friends in Christ,

Next weekend we will be praying the prayer for the canonization of **Fr. Stanley Rother**. July 28th is the 27th anniversary of Fr. Rother's death at our former Archdiocesan mission in Santiago Atitlan in Guatemala. Fr. Rother's heart is buried in the church in Santiago Atitlan and his body is buried at Holy Trinity Cemetery in Okarche. He was a priest, missionary and martyr who revealed the love of the Good Shepherd. Fr. Albert Bruecken, O.S.B., who presided at most of the Masses on the weekend of July 5-6 has been on loan from Conception Abbey in Missouri this summer to work on the cause for the canonization of Fr. Rother. Please pray daily for Fr. Rother to be declared a saint by using the prayer found on his prayer card. There is a simple shrine to Fr. Rother, with his photo and extra prayer cards, by the front entrance to the church.

JustFaith is one of those programs of intensive study and prayer that is life-changing. One of the best-kept secrets of the Catholic Church is her rich depository of Social Teachings, based on the dignity of every human person. JustFaith sprang from the RCIA model, and it is a 30-week program which includes weekly meetings, regular reading, retreats and immersion experiences. Our own Fr. Ross was part of our first JustFaith group which recently had their year-end retreat. A new JustFaith group begins this Fall in our parish. The International Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima will be visiting our parish on the evening of August 18th, kicking off 2 full days of continuous prayer. For those who are not able to go on the parish pilgrimage to Fatima this October, this visitation is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the message of Our Lady of Fatima and to seek the Blessed Virgin's intercession in a special way.
