Dear Friends in Christ,

Fr. Gil Garcia, one of the Catholic chaplains at Tinker Air Force Base, has been helping out occasionally with our Sunday Spanish Mass over the past couple of years. Fr. Gil is being transferred to England, so there will be a farewell party for him this Friday night @ 6 p.m. in the parish hall.

Both the bulletin for last week and this week contained an insert explaining some special needs for the homeless family that is living in the Laughlin House. As many of you know, the Laughlin House is located within our parish boundaries and was donated to Catholic Charities to use for housing needs. Our Laughlin House Committee works with Catholic Charities in assisting the homeless family that lives in the Laughlin House. The mother of the family has been diagnosed with terminal cancer, so special donations are needed to help her children and to help her. I am especially grateful to the members of the Laughlin House Committee for their dedication to this important ministry and to all the volunteers who have worked at the Laughlin House or made donations. The United States Catholic Conference of Bishops (USCCB) has marked the last week in July as "Natural Family Planning Week." The new methods of Natural Family Planning (NFP) are both scientific and easy to use, so there are more choices available to assist couples in achieving or avoiding a pregnancy. NFP has several benefits: it is safe and healthy; it enables a couple to increase communication and to better understand their own bodies; and NFP can contribute to greater intimacy, sharing and spirituality in a relationship. NFP is not the hit-and-miss rhythm method of decades past, but a highly scientific yet easy to use method to assist couples. Evidence shows NFP to be 97-98% effective in avoiding pregnancy when taught by a qualified teacher and correctly applied. For couples experiencing infertility, 70% achieve pregnancy within one year through teaching and charting alone.
