This past Wednesday was the first day of school for students attending our parish school. You are welcome to come to the weekly School Mass in the church at 8:15 a.m. on Thursdays---praying with children can certainly brighten one's day. About once a month all the schoolchildren from grades K-8 will be at this Thursday Mass, and the other Thursdays the 2nd-5th graders will be celebrating a "sectional" Mass. On these weeks, the 6th-8th graders will have their own "sectional" Mass on Tuesdays at 8:15 a.m. in the chapel (the regular 6:30 a.m. daily Mass will still be offered on Tuesdays). Since the chapel will be fairly full with the 6-8th graders, this Mass will be limited to family members of the students and not open to the entire parish.

Laura Davidoff and her mother, Susan Roberts, have started a new outreach ministry on behalf of our parish to those who are on our bulletin prayer list. It is called "Laura's Ministry." Laura has struggled with illness and has been touched by the support of others during her time of sickness, so she was inspired to start this ministry. To those who are on the prayer list, Laura and Susan deliver a beautiful vase of flowers with a prayer card containing the 23rd Psalm attached, as well as a brief greeting from me. (Susan and Laura have purchased the prayer cards, made copies of my greeting, and also buy the flowers.) A number of parishioners have responded positively to this outreach to those who are sick, homebound, or need prayers for other reasons. I have received several cards of thanks and several expressions of gratitude in person, and I try to pass these along to Laura and Susan whose kindness has touched people's lives.

The Altar Society is putting together a parish cookbook, which will be sold to raise funds towards the purchase of a new bell system for our church. Our bell system is very old and limited---newer systems can play chimes on the quarter hour, ring special bells for Sunday Masses, and even play songs. This project is in need of your favorite recipe, so please take a moment to stop by the countertop in the gathering area and place in the box provided your favorite recipe.

Registration for Religious Education classes takes place after Mass on this weekend and during upcoming weekends. Fr. Bill Ross will be gone from August 25 – September 2nd for some time away.

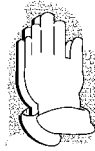
