Dear Friends in Christ,

Labor Day reminds us of the importance of human labor. We Catholics believe that work is more than a way to make a living; it is a form of continuing participation in God's creation. We believe the economy should serve people, not the other way around. So, in a marketplace where too often the quarterly bottom line takes precedence over the rights of workers, we are advocates for the dignity of work and the rights of workers, one of the seven themes highlighted by our Catholic social teaching tradition.

On the facing page of this bulletin you will find the new **schedule of prayer events on Wednesdays** for this Wednesday through the end of May. Confessions will be offered from 12:30 p.m. – 1:30 p.m. every Wednesday as well as Anointing of the Sick at 3 p.m. in the chapel every Wednesday.

This Tuesday evening the priests of the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City will gather to honor our jubilarians (those celebrating 25, 40, 50, or 60 years as a priest). This year the founding pastor of our parish, Fr. Jim Ross, celebrates his 60th anniversary. (The actual date of his ordination is December 21, 1946.) For those of you who were parishioners back in the late 1950's – early 1960's and would like to send him a card, you can mail it to him at the "Catholic Pastoral Center P.O. Next Sunday is the 10th Annual "**Festival of the Americas--International.**" Come to our Fellowship Hall between 11:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. for delicious food and lively entertainment. Because this festival starts right after the 10 a.m. Mass, coffee and donuts will not be served after the 10 a.m. Mass next Sunday.
