**Dear Friends in Christ,**

This weekend our catechists are commissioned for their important ministry of passing on the Faith. The word of God can only be accepted and understood if it is taught, and we are blessed with a number of parishioners who share their time and talent in this important ministry: catechists who teach Kindergarten – 8<sup>th</sup> grade on Wednesday evenings, High School catechists at Life Night on Sunday evening, school faculty who teach a religion class every day, RCIA catechists who share their faith with those interested in joining our Church, and leaders of adult education classes and faith-sharing small groups. Karen Bernardy (Director of Religious Education), Suzette Williams (School Principal), and Judi Wilkinson (Director of RCIA and Adult Formation) all do a fine job in training and supervising our catechists.

**After Communion a special collection will be taken up for Middle East Relief.** In response to Pope Benedict XVI's plea for those suffering in the Middle East, Archbishop Beltran has asked each parish in our Archdiocese to take up this collection for those suffering from the recent devastating conflicts in Israel, Palestine, and Lebanon. Donations will be divided equally between Catholic Relief Services/Catholic Near East Welfare Association and Most Reverend Elias Chacour, the Melkite Archbishop of Upper Galilee. Thanks to all who gave to the recent special collection for Hurricane relief—\$5767 has been collected so far.

Fr. Tom Sweetser and Sr. Peg Bishop of the Parish Evaluation Project (PEP) will start their work among us this coming Friday by meeting several hours with our parish staff. Then on Saturday, Fr. Tom and Sr. Peg will meet with parish leaders and parish staff members. Sr. Peg and Fr. Tom will be here for the weekend Masses and during their two week stay will help us assess where we are as a parish and where the Holy Spirit is calling us to renewal.

Jerry Rakosky and his wife, Carol Ann, and Alejandro Randolph and his wife, Malena, will be on a pre-ordination retreat for deacon candidates from September 13-17. Please keep them in your prayers this week. Jerry and Alejandro will be ordained on November 3rd to the permanent diaconate. Fr. Bill Ross will be away from September 7 - 19.
