Archbishop Beltran has asked all the parishes in our Archdiocese to take up a special collection on the weekends of September 3-4 and 10-11 to aid those suffering from Hurricane Katrina. As you can see below in the weekly section "Summary of Contributions," almost \$15,000 was donated this past week for "Hurricane Relief." All monies collected will be forwarded on to Catholic Charities USA, which will then distribute these donations to the dioceses in the hurricane stricken areas. Thanks to those of you who have responded so generously to this appeal. If you donate this weekend to this special appeal, please make your check out to "St. Eugene Church" and put "Hurricane Relief" in the notation section of your check. Please continue to pray daily for those suffering from this catastrophe and for those helping them.

Next weekend is the annual Catholic Charities Appeal. Your support through this annual appeal is a powerful way of fulfilling Jesus' command, "Whatsoever you do for the least of my brothers or sisters, you do for me." As of the printing of this bulletin, Catholic Charities is putting together a plan to help individuals and families who have been displaced by Hurricane Katrina who come to Oklahoma. Catholic Charities is asking parishes to sponsor a family, which our parish is going to do. I hope to have more information to share with you at Mass today.

On this 4th anniversary of September 11, 2001, we not only pray for those who died on that dark day and pray for their families and our country, but we also celebrate the richly diverse cultures that thrive here in the U.S.A. Our "**Festival of Americas: International**" has grown since its inception in 1996 to include food and entertainment from many different cultures represented in our parish. A new addition this year will be an outdoor stage set up in front of the school to accommodate more entertainment. Also, there are more games and activities for children this year. The festival starts after the 10 a.m. Mass (approximately 11:20 – 11:30 a.m.) with a special ceremony thanking the Village Police and Fire Department members who serve our school and parish so faithfully. All monies raised go to the general fund of our parish to support the many ministries that our parish provides.

Beginning this Sunday, childcare will be offered at the Sunday 5:30 p.m. Mass. The nursery will be available every Sunday at this Mass for parents who would like to avail themselves of this service.

On a sad note, **Nina Escalante died** this past Tuesday evening. Nina and her husband Carlos had been living in the Laughlin House, a home in our neighborhood that Catholic Charities provides for a homeless family and that our parish maintains for this family. Thanks to the members of our Laughlin House Committee, and to all of you who have given so generously of your time, talent, and material treasure in support of Nina and Carlos and their family during this difficult time.

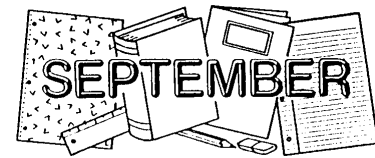
