Dear Padre:

I've been in a relationship with an atheist for almost a year. I love him very much, but he doesn't want to baptize our future children and I don't even know if I'd be able to get married in the Church. Please help me. Is it a sin to marry an atheist?

Dear Gaby,

First let me congratulate you on finding someone to love and, I pray, loves you. Secondly, it is not a sin to love an atheist. However, such a union requires special permission and is especially complicated if he has publicly renounced the Catholic faith. Another difficulty you might face is that the Catholic Church requires that you do everything in your power to raise your children Catholic. Both of you need to be in step with one another and moving in the same direction. So often couples run into trouble when they begin to head in different directions and possess different priorities. I hate to say it, but sometimes love is not enough when couples have very opposing views of what their life together means, as well as what their expectations are of the other person. But I do not say this to discourage you. "For all things are possible through Christ who saves me." The marvelous thing about loving someone is that it has the power to change us like nothing else. Love gives us the strength to sacrifice, to set aside our fears and prejudices, and to reexamine even our own belief systems. The best advice I can give you is to talk with each other about what you believe and why you believe it. Share with each other your hopes as well as your fears.
