Both Fr. Ross and I will be gone on retreat this coming week, as will most of the priests of our Archdiocese. Fr. Ross will celebrate the 6:30 a.m. Monday morning Mass and then leave later on Monday. I will also be leaving Monday and returning Friday evening. One of the priests from the Apostles of Jesus religious community will celebrate the daily Masses during the week (including the School Mass). However, on Wednesday there will not be a priest here for Confessions at 12:30 p.m., nor Anointing of the Sick at 3 p.m. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will still take place all day Wednesday, and though there will not be Benediction at the end of the day, Evening Prayer and Reposition will occur at 8:30 p.m.

Five of our high school youth will leave Wednesday night with over a hundred other youth from our Archdiocese on a bus trip to Atlanta for the National Catholic Youth Conference (NCYC). Mark Marianos, Greg Latta, Josh Wilson, Diana Kwiatkowski, and Angelica Grajeda will join thousands of Catholic youth from around the U.S. in worship, fellowship, and learning more deeply what it means to be Catholic. They will return here next Sunday night, October 30<sup>th</sup>. Our Coordinator of Youth and Young Adult Ministry, Debbie Blomquist, will also make this journey with them and will be one of the adult chaperones. Mark, Greg, Josh, Diana, and Angelica will be selling "stock" after the Masses to raise funds to pay for this trip. One share of stock grants the owner the privilege of being served dinner in the near future and hearing about this incredible experience directly from these youth who will attend NCYC in Atlanta. This national conference takes place every other year, and I had the privilege of attending NCYC in Indianapolis several years ago with over 20,000 Catholic youth. I know from my powerful experience that our youth will have plenty to share upon their return.

The "Las Mujeres en Accion con Cristo" (our Hispanic women's group) will be selling homemade tamales after the 5 p.m. Saturday Mass on October 22 and October 29<sup>th</sup>. All funds raised are for the general fund of our parish. Major repair work (estimated to cost \$13,000) has taken place on the roof over the gathering area this past week and hopefully will be completed by Monday. Next weekend (Oct. 29-30) a member of the Finance Committee will speak briefly at each Mass about this year's budget. The 2005-2006 budget was published in the October issue of the *Gospel Truth* but was incorrectly labeled as the 2004-2005 budget (the budget and actual amounts for last year--2004-2005--were also mislabeled as 2003-2004 in this report in the *Gospel Truth*).
