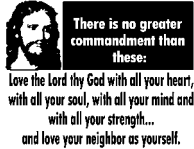

**Dear Friends in Christ,**

We had our first Leadership Night on Thursday evening, October 26. The members of our Five Commissions (Worship, Community Life, Administration, Outreach, and Formation) gathering together for prayer, breaking off into their own Commission meetings, then regrouping to hear the reports of what each Commission accomplished. Then the two Pastoral Council representatives from each Commission met together with Deacon Bill Bawden and me for our Pastoral Council meeting. Enclosed in this bulletin is a one-page report of the results of our first Leadership Night. Thanks to Greg Main and Fr. Bill Ross for helping facilitate that gathering.

Our Parish Assessment and Renewal process brought about the above restructuring of our parish ministries and also has been the impetus behind recent changes in our Parish Staff. A couple of years ago the members of our Parish Staff discussed the need for a **bilingual receptionist.** Deacon Bill Bawden recently interviewed a number of candidates for this position, and then the decision was made to hire **Gloria Pantazis.** Gloria is a member of the Catholic Parish of St. John the Baptist in Edmond. She is of Cuban descent, speaks and writes fluently in both English and Spanish, is a former teacher and just recently was working for Telemundo. She will start work in the parish office this Monday, and will be here from 8 a.m. – 12 noon, and 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. (Hopefully some of our office volunteers will continue to staff the office during the lunch hour.) Gloria will not only answer the phone and welcome people to the office, but she will also provide clerical assistance to Deacon Bill Bawden and to the Religious Education Department.

There are other changes that are happening within the Parish Staff. **Brent McWilliams** has gone from working full-time as Director of Liturgy and Music to working part-time (24 hours a week) as Director of Music. Deirdre Hite will no longer serve as Parish Counselor, but will focus her efforts on being Communications Director, mainly working to improve the monthly newsletter (The Gospel Truth) and our website. Deirdre has been meeting with a newly formed Communications Committee for the past 6 weeks. **Maureen Brown**, who has been working full-time as office assistant since October 1, now is doing the parish calendar, scheduling use of parish facilities. She also is responsible for the ministry schedule and will be working with a Volunteer Committee to better serve the volunteers in our parish. Maureen will also be my administrative assistant, taking care of setting appointments for me and helping me in other ways. Some physical changes will take this week regarding office space. Our parish and school accountant, Wanda Buckner, will move to Deirdre Hite's office at the far east end of the parish plant near the chapel. Deirdre will move to one of the front office desks (where Maureen is presently stationed) and Maureen will move into Wanda's former office (right across from my office.)

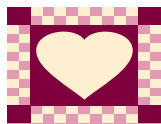
