This Sunday we conclude another liturgical year as we celebrate Christ the King Sunday. This "Year of Matthew" ends with Matthew's famous Last Judgment scene with the startling reminder that we serve the King of Kings whenever we do deeds of mercy for the least ones.

Next Sunday we begin a new liturgical year with the 1st Sunday of Advent. There will be no Communal Penance Rite during Advent this year, but there will be extended times for the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confessions). Confessions will be offered on Wednesday evenings in Advent (Nov. 30, Dec. 7, 14, 21) from 7:00-8:30 p.m. Also, Confessions will continue to be offered during the day on Wednesdays (as they have throughout the school year) from 12:30 – 1:30 p.m. The schoolchildren who come to Confession have been instructed to allow any adults who come during that time period to go to the front of the Confessional line. Also, the time for Confessions on Saturday afternoons in Advent will be extended 30 minutes from 3:00-4:30 p.m. **There will be no Confessions offered on Saturday afternoon, Christmas Eve.** In a future bulletin issue I will have a list of times for Communal Penance Rites in our area.

The Choir Concert last Sunday by our 10 a.m. Mass choir at St. Edward's Chapel on the Casady School campus was very well done with beautiful sacred music. CD's of this concert will soon be on display in the display case near the parish office, selling for \$10. Also, in the very near future an order form to purchase CD's will be on our website. Speaking of concerts, **another concert in the series of Virginia Campbell concerts will take place this Sunday afternoon at 3 p.m.** here in our church. Bring your bulletin as your free pass and enjoy some exquisite piano music by Valery Kulechov.

Two months ago the parishes throughout the Archdiocese held the annual **Catholic Charities Appeal**. As of this week, 271 donors in our parish have pledged \$90,397 toward this appeal. Thanks to those who have shared so generously of their material treasure so Catholic Charities, in our name and helped by our gifts, can serve Christ present in the least ones. Also, this month you will find an envelope in your envelope packet for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD), which is a response to the Church's call to bring a lasting end to poverty across our nation. Poverty in America is on the rise--nearly 36 million Americans live below the poverty line. But one by one, people are joining local community groups to break the cycle of poverty, and Catholics across our country are part of that change. Join in solidarity with the CCHD to end poverty one community at a time. Your generous gift to CCHD will help low-income people across the U.S.A. as they work together to solve community problems, increase educational opportunities, and create jobs.

Mass will be celebrated on Thanksgiving Day at 9 a.m. with Fr. Ross presiding. **I will be gone from Thanksgiving Day, November 24 – Tuesday night, November 28th.**

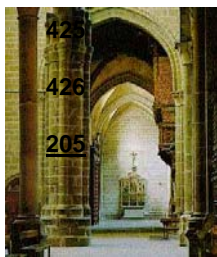
