Dear Friends in Christ,

Mary, the Mother of God, is one of the central figures of the Advent Season. She teaches us how to wait in hope for the coming of the Savior and how to receive him with joy. So it is fitting that there are two important Marian feast days during Advent: the Immaculate Conception of Mary on December 8th and Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 12th.

Our Blessed Mother appeared to Juan Diego as "Our Lady of Guadalupe" in the early 16th century in what is now present-day Mexico City. Her message of hope to this native-born Aztec Indian transformed this continent. She appeared to Juan Diego as one of his own people, as any Aztec woman would look who was pregnant with child. She brought her son to Juan Diego and to the native people of the Americas and also to the conquistadors, the ruling Spaniards. Almost 500 years later, the image of Our Lady is still vividly imprinted on Juan Diego's cloak, located in the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City.

Our Blessed Mother, under the title "Our Lady of Guadalupe" is the Patroness of all the Americas (North, Central, and South). Her message reminds us that we are all children of our Heavenly Father and all sisters and brothers to one another and to her son, Jesus. There will be a bi-lingual Mass at 7 p.m. this Tuesday night, followed by a fiesta in the gym with delicious food and music. All parishioners are invited to attend the Mass and/or the fiesta.
